

## Oakville Public Library 3D Printing Agreement Terms of Use & Waiver

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Welcome to 3D printing at Oakville Public library. Please review the guidelines and policies set forth below. Acceptance of and compliance with these provisions is required before using the 3D printer or allowing your child (under 18) to use the 3D printer.

- The 3D Certification course must be completed.
- There must be no printing of weapons, sexually explicit material, and other materials that violate the [library's policies](#) or the [RZone](#) policy of the Town of Oakville.
- Print jobs must be completed at least 30 minutes before the library closes.
- Cost must be paid in full upon completion of the print job.
- Full replacement or repair cost will be charged for lost or damaged equipment.
- There must be no infringement of intellectual property rights, such as copyright.
- OPL is not responsible for any defects in the equipment or materials used.

I am aware that using the 3D printer may result in risk of personal injury or harm. I do hereby agree to waive any and all claims against the Oakville Public Library, the Oakville Public Library Board and the Town of Oakville for any personal injury, illness, death, damages, claims, or liability resulting from my use or my child's use of the 3D printer.

I also agree to indemnify the library, the library board and the Town of Oakville for any liability arising from claims brought by a third party arising from my use or my child's use of the 3D printer. (continued on p2).
